



SECTION V: HEALTH HAZARD DATA

Effects of Overexposure

EYES - LIQUID OR VAPOR CONTACT MAY CAUSE EYE IRRITATION.
SKIN - BRIEF CONTACT CAN BE MILDLY IRRITATING. AVOID EXCESSIVE CONTACT.
INHALATION - VAPORS CAN BE IRRITATING TO NOSE AND THROAT. SYMPTOMS OF OVEREXPOSURE MAY INCLUDE HEADACHE, NAUSEA, VOMITING, DROWSINESS.
INGESTION - SLIGHTLY TOXIC

Medical Conditions Prone to Aggravation by Exposure
HEART CONDITIONS, ASTHMA

Primary Routes of Entry into the Body, and Effects
INHALATION, DERMAL CONTACT, EYE CONTACT, INGESTION.

EMERGENCY FIRST-AID PROCEDURES

EYES - FLUSH WITH WATER FOR 15 MINUTES.
SKIN - WASH WITH SOAP AND WATER, REMOVE CONTAMINATED CLOTHING.
INHALATION - REMOVE TO FRESH AIR. PROVIDE OXYGEN IF BREATHING IS DIFFICULT.
INGESTION - DO NOT GIVE LIQUIDS IF UNCONSCIOUS. OTHERWISE, GIVE NO MORE THAN 2 GLASSES OF WATER AND INDUCE VOMITING.
